'RISER SYSTEM' SCENARIO PRPOSAL

A proposal for an additional scenario (Riser system) to run the elimination stage (Rule C.6.4) had been submitted by Germany to be published on the last year Plenary Meeting Agenda.

The goal of the proposal was to offer possibility to all competitors of the event to participate to the elimination stage after the qualification stage.

The recommendation of the F9 Technical Meeting 14th November 2020 to refer the proposal back to the F9 Subcommittee for further consideration have been adopted by the CIAM Delegate.

A Subcommittee Working Group (WG) has been set up end December 2020 as follows:

The WG considers that the Riser system in its proposed form does not improve the current Sporting Code.

The WG will study new options to maximize flight opportunities to all competitors, to equalize the number of flights and waiting times before a race, and to minimize the effects of mid-air collisions or video issues.
