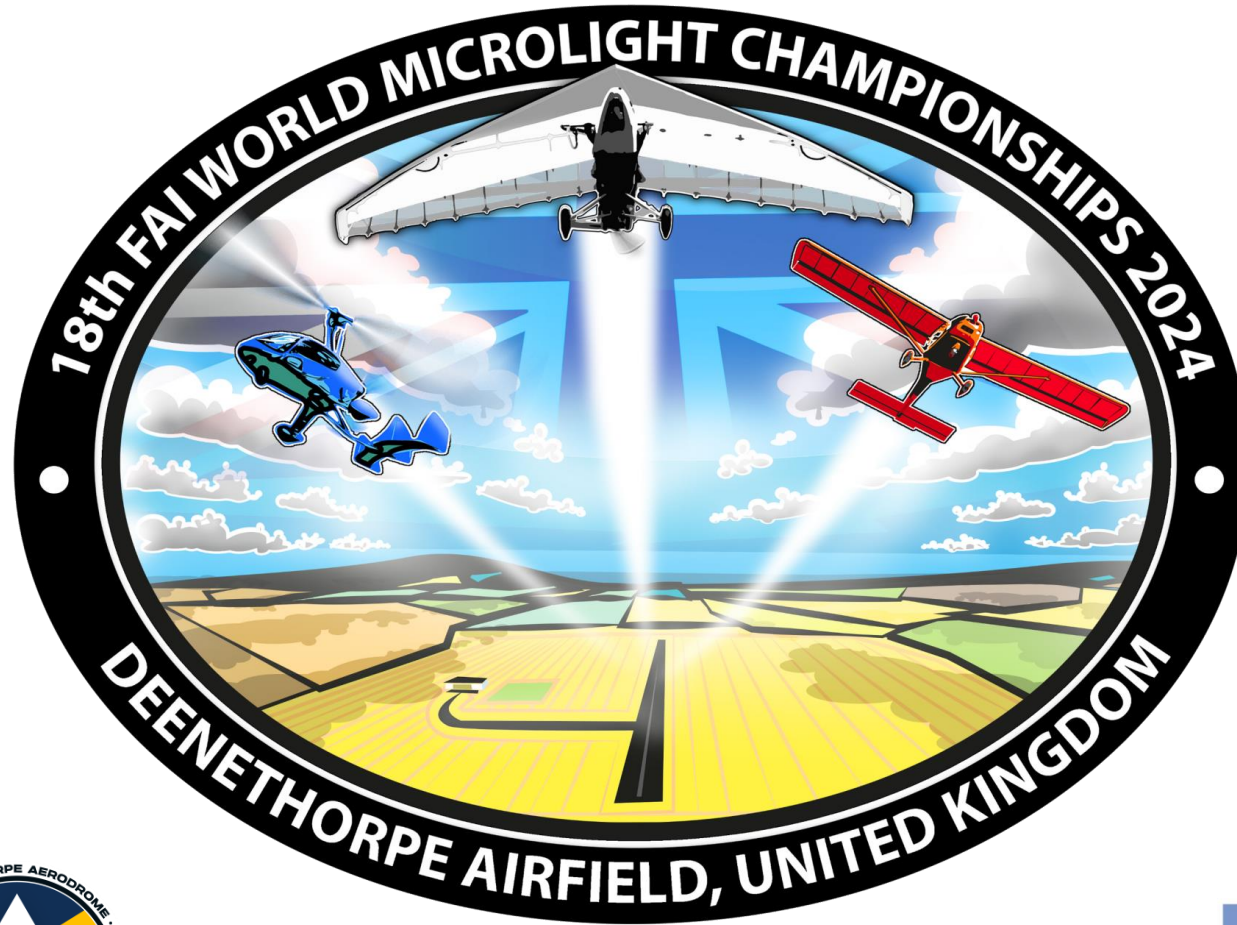

Successful test event hosting approx. 25 aircraft from 5 countries to prove Deenethorpe as a venue.

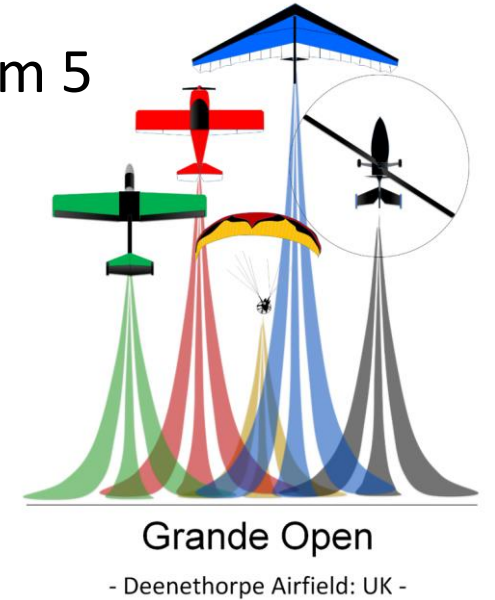


Positive feedback received, lots learnt.

- Pre-registration introduced



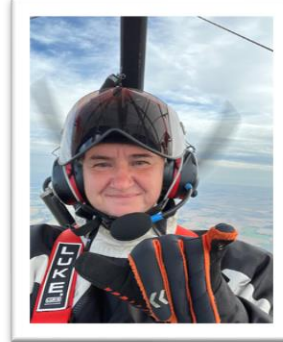

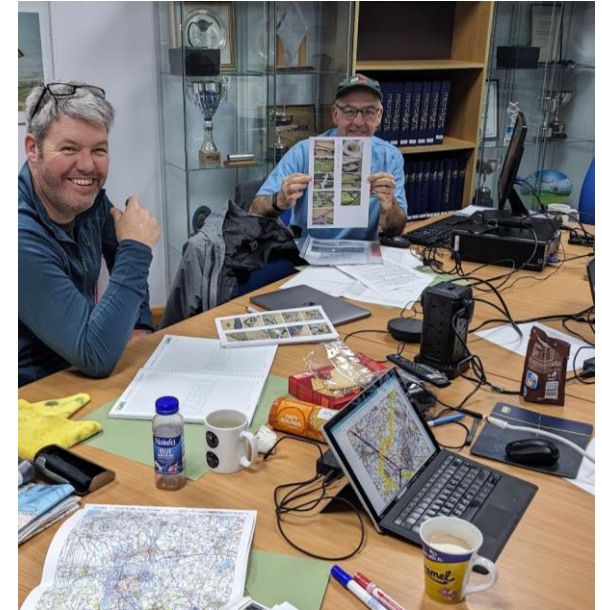

- Aim is to enable competing pilots to have as much information to ensure a smooth start to briefings and practice week



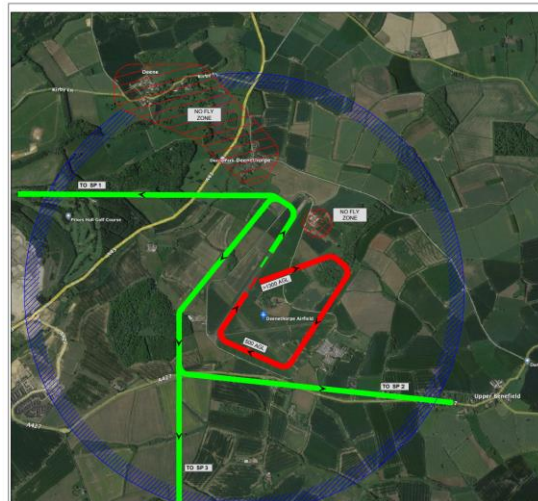
18th World Microlight Championships  
Deenethorpe Airfield - Corby - England  
Procedure B - Airfield Setup  
Take Off Deck 22 & Landing Deck 22

All departures and take off's will be from 22  
Hard Runway.

All Arrivals and landings will be on 22 Grass  
Runway.

All aircraft must depart the airfield to the WEST  
after take off.  
DO NOT CROSS OVER THE EXTENDED  
FLIGHT LINE OF THE LANDING DECK

Upon ARRIVAL all aircraft must join overhead  
at not less than 1300ft AGL and only descend  
on the East side of the airfield. All landings  
must be within the grass landing deck.



18th World Microlight Championships  
Deenethorpe - Corby - England  
Procedure A - Circuits  
Departure & Arrival Lanes Runway 04

All departing aircraft must climb out and turn west  
following the departure lanes as marked. You must  
not exceed 1000ft AGL whilst within the 2.5km  
diameter Restricted Height Zone.

All arriving Aircraft must be above 1300ft AGL  
before entering the 2.5km diameter Restricted  
Height Zone. Once overhead the landing deck,  
aircraft shall begin their descent on the Eastern side  
of the runway as shown

Descending to go around the trees, once within  
the airfield perimeter boundary, landing aircraft shall  
not exceed the airfield boundary line.

No Fly Zones include the farm on the NE corner of  
the airfield and the two villages of Deene &  
Deenethorpe





# 5 months to go

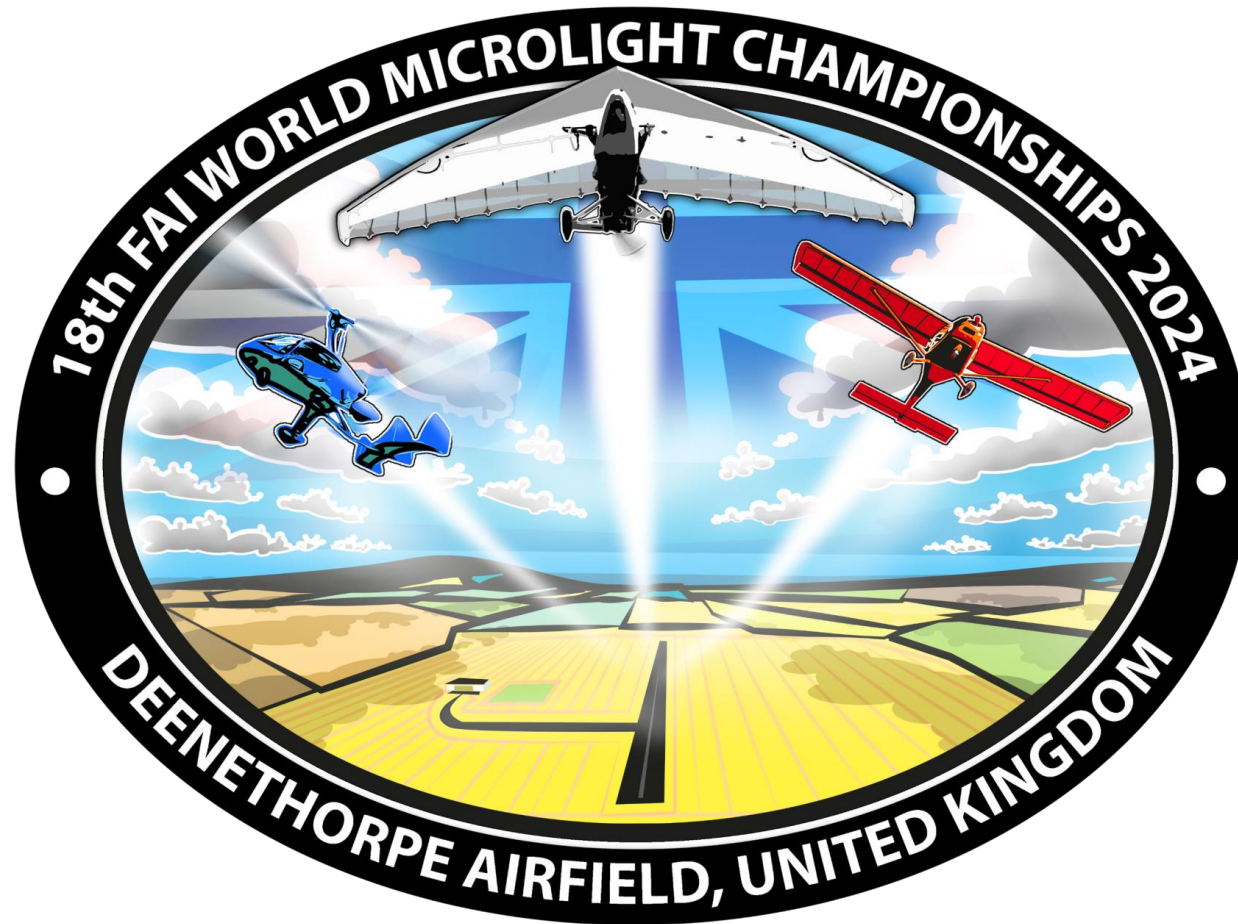
- Catering team in place with theme nights and app booking
