Benvenutas Ivanauskas, an independent old aircraft enthusiast, during 2010 's and 2020 's has restored over a of vintage glider aircraft or built their replicas. The most notable reconstructions are the replicas of Lithuanian-desistrainer gliders Technikas T-1 (BrO) (1932) and Bro-9 " Ziogas" (1952). Mr. Ivanauskas is engaged into aircraft restoration activities since mid-2000 's, when he was working as a technic the Lithuanian Museum of Aviation. There he was in charge in restoring Museum 's exhibits. Having quit his work Museum Mr. Ivanauskas continued as independent aircraft technician, with the hobby of vintage aircraft restoration Working independently Mr. Ivanauskas has done major repairs to over a dozen of vintage gliders like Schleicher K Schleicher Ka 6, Schleicher K-6E, three B Scheibe Bergfalke III, Oskinis Bro – 11M "Zyl", JR-1 etc. Further to the restoration of vintage aircraft, Mr. Ivanauskas is an active promoter of gliding, aviation sports and aviation-based community building. He is the core organizer of community aviation events, where restored BrO-1/BrO-9 are used to promote aviation, gather community of interest, engage children into aviation.
