Individual Classifications

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third for juniors and seniors.

In order to award the title of Junior World Champion, junior competitors from at least four nations must participate in the class.

For the additional female senior classification, FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third.

The best female earns the title of senior Female World Champion if females from at least four different nations participate in that class.

For the additional female junior classification, FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third.

The best female earns the title of junior Female World Champion if females from at least four different nations participate in that class

Team classification

For the team ranking the best three results of the team will be considered.

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to each members and the team manager of the teams placed first, second and third.

9. NATIONAL TEAM

Each member of the FAI-CIAM may enter a team consisting of:

- team manager
- team manager assistant
- maximum 4 competitors senior, providing that at least one competitor is a female
- maximum 4 competitors junior, providing that at least one competitor is a female - age limit 18 years in the year 2022
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning senior World Champion
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning junior World Champion (referring to the CIAM General Rule 2022)
- official helpers, supporters

10. LICENCES

Each competitor, team manager and assistant of team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License, valid for 2022, issued by their NAC, included in the FAI Sporting Licence Database.

The holder of a FAI Sporting Licence may be required to present an official document bearing his photograph and signature as proof of identity.

Organizers must use the FAI Sporting Licences validity check website for final verification of these Sporting Licences for all Team members.

18. PROTEST

Rules

All protests must be presented in writing to the Sports Director at the competition site, and must be accompanied by a deposit of the fee. The fee is 50 € according to the FAI

Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling, Volume ABR 2019 Edition. The deposit is returned if the protest is upheld only.

19. MODELS PROCESSING

FAI Specification Certificate

Each competitor must present a valid FAI SPECIFICATION CERTIFICATE for his model(s) from his NAC, according to FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling, Volume CIAM General Rules 2022 Edition.

Model aircraft not properly processed by the NAC, must be processed by the organiser at a cost of 8€ for each model.

21. REGISTRATION

Team manager must present on registration:

- ID card or Passport
- Final entry form signed and stamped by the National Air Sports Control (NAC)
- A copy of the teams banking payment of the Entry fee receipt

22. VISA REQUIREMENTS

23. ALLOWED FREQUENCIES

35 MHz, 40 MHz, 2,4 GHz

Organiser strongly recommends 2,4 GHz

24. PLACE IN HANGAR

Pilots can use hangars for planes. Each place will be equipped with electricity connection provided for model charging. Price per 1 pilot 10 € for all contest. Size of the place depends on numbers of pilots from national team.

25. INSURANCE

The organiser will provide third party insurance in accordance with paragraph B.8.9 of Volume ABR of the FAI Sporting Code only. Any other type of insurance should be covered by the participants. Citizens from EU must bring EC-111 health insurance certificate. Non EU citizens must provide own insurance and a copy must be enclosed to the final entry.

26. COVID-19 Safety Information

Bulletin – 2 and all the following documentation will include all the necessary information and the protocols that the organizers and the participants will have to follow in order to participate based on the national regulations and the FAI recommendations. Always the national regulations prevail at all times over FAI recommendations. From time to time please visit the [FAI web site COVID19 section](#) for any updates. Our web site will also be updated for this matter when so needed.

27. COVID-19 Deadline

As it happened last year with all World or Continental Championships, as organizers we will be in direct contact with CIAM Bureau in order to evaluate together the situation and decide accordingly.
