Clarification and further information regarding Reserve Repacks for International Competitors

11. Equipment – Reserve Repack Requirements

Please note that the US Federal Aviation Administration does not have a reciprocity agreement to allow foreign skydivers to use their equipment as accepted by their own NAC. Unless the equipment has *no* components with a Technical Standard Order, the parachutes must be packed according to US Federal Aviation Regulations. **This means packed by an FAA certified rigger, within 180 days, and with a seal on the reserve.**

We have been trying for several months to get a waiver from the Federal Aviation Administration regarding the reserve parachute requirements but with no luck. Please let your competitors know the following information for the World Championships at Eloy, Arizona:

- 1. All reserve parachutes must have been packed within the past 180 days.
- 2. The pin must be sealed with either:
 - a) lead seal

or

- b) a paper seal with the parachute rigger's seal symbol or initials.
- 3. This parachute rigger needs to have signed a data card that has the date of the last re-pack with the serial number of the parachute components on the card.

We do not allow Argus AAD's even if they are Turned OFF. If a competitor has an Argus branded AAD, they will need to remove them prior to the World Championships.

If your competitor's are unable to fulfill these requirements, they will need to hire a parachute rigger in Arizona to re-pack their reserve.

It would be extremely helpful to know how many competitors will be needing repacks prior to their arrival.
