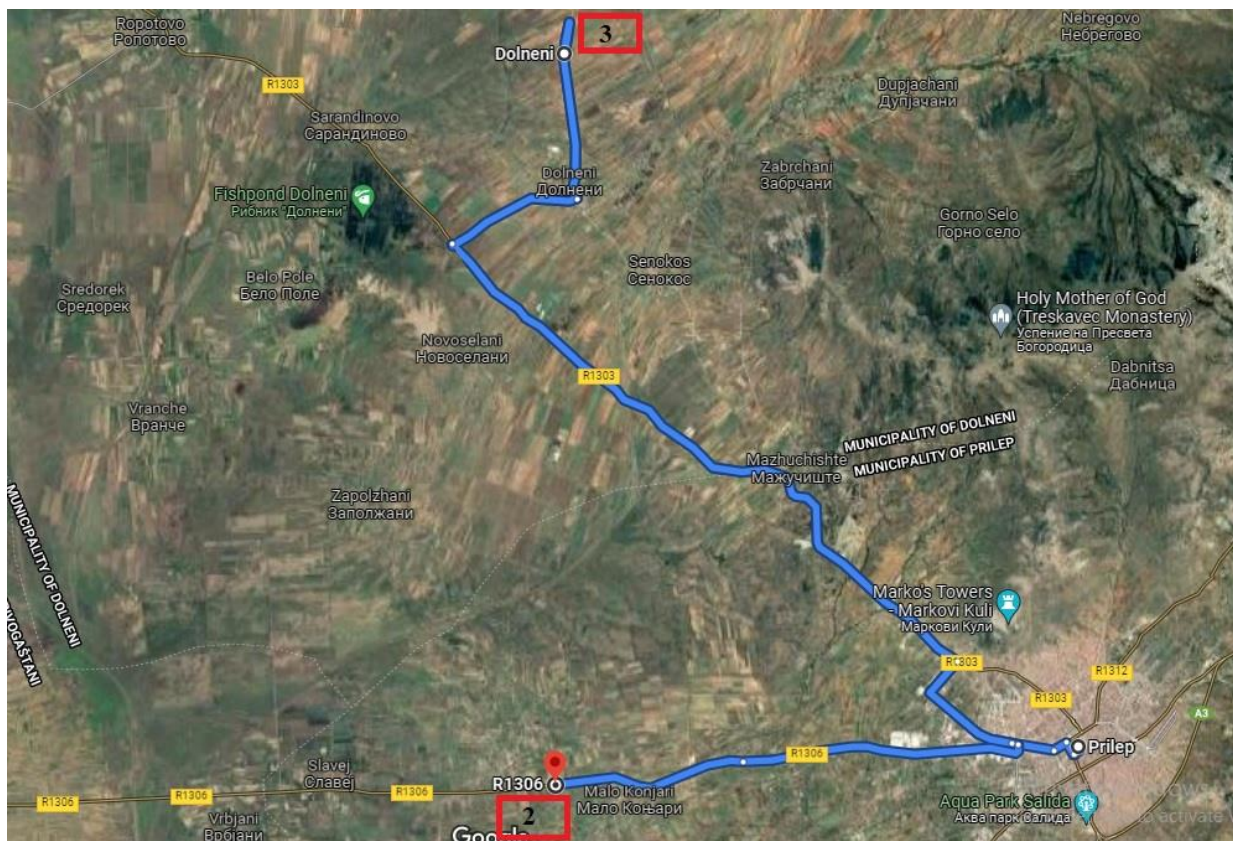

- The distance between Prilep and Skopje is 125 km, and to the airport in Skopje is 110 km;

FAI Sporting Code: Section 4, Volume ABR by Volume CGR 2022 & Volume F1, Edition January 2022

Anti-doping

All participants are to abide by the WADA anti-doping rules. If a competitor has to take, for a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

SPORTING LICENSE

All competitors are requested to hold a valid FAI License, entered on the FAI database.

PARTICIPATION - NATIONAL TEAMS

Every Active or Associated Member / National Air Sport Control (NAC) of the FAI (as defined in FAI S/C Gen Sec. 3.5.4.3.) is invited to enter a National Team that may consist of:

- Team manager
- Team manager's Assistant
- Maximum 3 (three) competitors per class, or 4 (four) competitors if at least one is female.
- Helpers, supporters, press representatives
- 2018 reigning European Champions in each F1A, F1B, F1C class.

The reigning Champions have the right (subject to the approval of their NAC) to participate in the championship(s) in that class regardless of whether or not he qualifies for the national team. If he is not a member of the national team, his score or place will not be considered in the team results. This also applies to reigning Junior Champions who are too old to defend their title at the relevant Junior Championships.

TIMEKEEPERS

All countries participant can have one timekeeper who have to be equipped with stopwatch, binocular and tripod of their own. For all delegated timekeepers organizer will have accommodation and meal. Application for the timekeeper will be announced in the Entry Form. All these timekeepers should speak basic technical English.

REGISTRATION OF PARTICIPANTS

During registration the Team Managers must present:

- Competitors, Team Manager, FAI Licenses valid for 2020 registered in the FAI Data Base;
- Final Entry Form signed and stamped by the National Air Sports Control;
- A copy of the teams banking payment of the Entry Fee receipt;
- One national flag 1.0 m x 1.5 m and National anthem MP3 format. National flag and USB will be returned before your departure;
- FAI ID certificates

CLASSIFICATIONS AND AWARDS

- Individual classification.
- Team classification.
- General team classification.

RESULTS AND AWARDS

Official website for European Championships www.euchamp2022.prilepcup.info will be updated with all necessary information and daily with results during the Championships.

The first 3 individuals and teams (including Team Managers) in each class shall be awarded with the FAI medals and diplomas and also with the cups of the Organizer.

Organizer will awarded the first three teams in general classification.

Also, in the ceremony will be awarded "Jack North Memorial" the FAI perpetual trophy for General Classification.

ENTRY FEES

1. Entry fee per competitor *Note: if competitor is flying more than one event the second entry fee will be discounted by 50%.	300 euros
2. Entry fee for team manager and assistant team manager *Note: if team manager or assistant team manager is also a competitor then they will only pay the competitor fee.	200 euros
3. Helper and Supporter fee There will be no fee for spectators, but they will not be permitted access to flight line and/or downwind retrieval.	50 euros

MODELS PROCESSING

Each model must have a valid FAI Specification Certificate for his model/s/, according to FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling. Volume ABR by Volume CIAM General Rules 2022 Edition.

Number of Models Allowed

During the initial processing, the participant will be allowed to process a total of four models.

Processing of Models

Models randomly selected for processing during the contest will be weighed and checked for proper markings and identification. F1A lines will be measured and F1B motors will be weighed.

The first, second, and third-place winners will have the models used during that contest processed immediately after the last flight. Models will be weighed and measured for adherence to the FAI Sporting Code.

COMPLAINTS

The purpose of a complaint is to obtain a correction without the need to make a formal protest. Complaints are made to the Contest Director and may be verbal.

PROTEST

Any protest must be presented in writing form in English to the Contest Director at the competition site, and must be accompanied by the deposit of 50 EUR. The deposit is returned only if the protest is upheld.

ENTRY FORMS, PAYMENT AND BANKING INFORMATION:

Each entering NAC is asked to send the attached Preliminary Entry Form to upon correspondence address completely filled. It must be received by the Organizers no later than February, 28th, 2022.

The payer of the registration must pay and bank charges for the transfer of money, with **„our“** indication. Otherwise bank charges, he must pay later.

Note: Final Entry Form and fee not will be accepted after June 10, 2022, except in of force majeure and exceptional circumstances, only with prior arrangement with the organizer.

ACCOMMODATION & FULL- BOARD COSTS ESTIMATION

Cost Calculation Per Person (Contains: Entry Fee, Banquet, Accommodation & Meals)
300 EUR + 40 + 20 Euro/7 day (= 140 Euro) + **20 Euro/6 day** (=120 Euro)

Total Cost for the whole championships per person: **600 EUR.**

INSURANCE

The organizer will provide third party insurance for all participants of Championship for accidents involving injury to others of damage to property according to the host country legislation during competition. It is recommended that individual health and travel insurance be purchased before traveling.

POWER SUPPLY

Electricity is 220 V / 50 Hz

MEDICAL SERVICE: Medical service will be present on the field whole time of the competition with emergency service.

THE VEHICLE ON THE COMPETITION SITE: Participants of the competition can use on the field only two-wheel vehicles (bicycles and mopeds) for the research for models. Cars can only be used from the front door of the airfield to the parking lot and back.

PRESS ACCESS

The access on the flying site of press representatives, photographers, etc., will be free of charge and allowed only in the special designated area of the contest.

CAR RENTALS

For competitors arriving at Skopje and Ohrid Airport, most major car rental companies are present in the arrival hall.
