

FAI unveils Drone Racing lineup for The World Games 2025

Lausanne, Switzerland, 5 February 2025 – FAI, the World Air Sports Federation, has announced an official list of 30 qualified athletes for the Drone Racing event at The World Games 2025, set to take place in Chengdu, China from 13 to 16 August 2025. This highly anticipated competition will see the world's top pilots battle for glory in an electrifying display of speed, skill, and precision.

The selection of the qualified athletes, which includes **11 juniors and six female pilots**, was based on performances in key FAI-sanctioned events. The 2024 FAI World Drone Racing Championship, held in Hangzhou, China, and the FAI Drone Racing World Cup series played a crucial role in determining the final rankings. This rigorous selection process ensures that the world's most skilled and dedicated pilots, representing the **widest possible range of countries—21 in total**, will compete in Chengdu.
