Krosno has a great experience in organising balloon competitions. Every year since 2000 we have organised international balloon competitions called Gorskie Zawody Balonowe in the rank of Polish Cup,a few times we have organised Polish Championship. In 2024, Krosno will again organise the Polish Championship.

The level of organisation of the event, attractive and varied competition conditions attract the largest number of participants of any competition held in Poland. It is worth mentioning that our balloon events are very popular among foreign participants (e.g. from Lithuania, Hungary or Slovakia).

On average, our competitions have attracted over 40 participants, with a record of over 50 competitors.

Six flights are scheduled during each competition, usually between 25 and 30 tasks. Due to favourable weather conditions, the vast majority of scheduled flights took place.
